



Razi School Uniform Policy (Grades 6–12)

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we prepare for the 2025–2026 school year, we ask for your full cooperation in following our updated uniform policy. These guidelines support modesty, discipline, and a focused academic environment. Please review the details below to ensure your child is dressed appropriately each day.

◆ **General Guidelines (All Students)**

- Uniforms must be **clean, complete, and ironed** each day
- **No makeup, nail polish, long nails, or excessive jewelry**
- **Hair must be neat, clean, and natural in color**
- **Socks must be worn** – bare feet or ankles are not permitted
- **Shoes:** Black sneakers or shoes with rubber soles (**no sandals, boots, or slippers**)
- **Sweaters/Hoodies:** Plain gray only, loose-fitting, with **no logos or designs**
- **Jackets** must be placed **inside lockers upon arrival** and not worn during the school day
- **No accessories** (hats, scarves, etc.) with bright colors, logos, or messages inside the building

◆ **Boys' Uniform**

- **Top:** White polo shirt or white button-down shirt (must be tucked in)
- **Bottom:** Black dress pants or khaki pants (**no jeans, joggers, or sweatpants**)
- **Outerwear (Indoor):** Plain gray sweater or hoodie

◆ Girls' Uniform

- **Abaya:** Plain black only (ankle-length, simple, loose-fitting, **no beads, embroidery, or designs**)
- **Undergarments:** Plain black **leggings or slacks** underneath (no jeans or pajama pants)
- **Hijab:** White only, securely pinned under the chin
 - A **headpiece must be worn underneath** to keep hair fully covered
 - **No visible hair; hijab must not be see-through**
 - **Pull-on styles are recommended** for neatness and ease

◆ PE Days (All Students)

- Students may wear gym clothes (**modest sweatpants or shorts**) **only during gym class**
- Must **change back into full school uniform** after class
- Gym clothing must meet **modesty and cleanliness** standards

◆ Consequences for Dress Code Violations

- **First Violation:** Phone call home
- **Repeated Violations:** Student will be sent home to change
- **Ongoing Non-Compliance:** May result in further disciplinary action
